### Event Rules, Terms & Conditions of entry

- ❖ The Exhibitor's and Trade Stand entrance gate will be open from 7am on both Saturday and Sunday. The site is a large field near Froxfield and High Cross, opposite The Trooper Inn on the road that runs from Hedge Corner (A32) to Petersfield. Nearest post code GU32 1BD. What3Words <https://w3w.co/compose.drooling.equipment>. Please arrive in a timely manner to allow time for set up ready to start at 10am. The exhibitor's and trade stand entrance gate will be shut at **10.30am** prompt on both days. **For Health & Safety reasons, there will be no admittance for late arrivals and no "on the day" entries.**
- ❖ The maximum speed limit is 5 mph and must be strictly adhered to.
- ❖ All Trade Stand exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their guests, children and any pets. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times and all dog fouling must be cleaned up and disposed of appropriately. WHTIC will not be held responsible for any loss of goods or damage howsoever caused by a third party during the event.
- ❖ Disposable BBQs will not be permitted on site, only gas BBQs. Fire pits must be above the ground and not left unattended at all times and extinguished after use and taken home.
- ❖ Camping pitches will be available and provided free of charge to Exhibitors on a first come first served basis. Fresh water is available on site and chemical waste disposal facility but no EHU. Please ensure that all rubbish is disposed of appropriately and clear your area and adjoining areas each day after the event.
- ❖ All catering vans and equipment must have a current Hygiene Certificate and comply with local Health & Safety Regulations.
- ❖ Any instructions given by the site Marshalls must be followed and adhered to at all time.
- ❖ Non-compliance of any of these conditions will result in you being asked to leave the site immediately.
- ❖ **Please ensure when you return this form, you enclose a correctly stamped, addressed envelope. This will be used to confirm your entry and to send the passes to you.**
